Dear Applicant:

We're pleased to tell you we determined you're exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(3). 
You formed December 22, 2016, and filed your Form 1023, *Application for Recognition of Exemption Under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code*, on December 30, 2020. You failed to file a required annual return or notice (Form 990, Form 990-EZ, Form 990-PF, or Form 990-N) for three consecutive years after you formed and while your application was pending. As a result, your tax-exempt status was automatically revoked on May 15, 2021, the due date of your third year return or notice. We're treating your Form 1023 as an application for reinstatement and are recognizing your exemption as reinstated on the same day it was automatically revoked. As a result, you are recognized as tax exempt continuously from the effective date of exemption as listed at the top of this letter.

If we indicated at the top of this letter that you're required to file Form 990/990-EZ/990-N, our records show you're required to file an annual information return (Form 990 or Form 990-EZ) or electronic notice (Form 990-N, the e-Postcard). If you don't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked.

If we indicated at the top of this letter that an addendum applies, the enclosed addendum is an integral part of this letter.
